With reference to your letter dated 27th September 1965, please be advised that only the following information is contained in our records :

CORDREY, William, born 20 July 1892 in Dalhousie, Scotland, Nationality: British, Occupation: warehouse worker, mechanician, Religion: Protestant, Wife: Edith nee McKintosh, Residence: 60 New Street, St. Helier, Jersey, entered Prison Rheinbach on 8 June 1944, coming from St. Helier, Jersey, Prisoner's No. 317/44, and was transferred to Hameln on 16 September 1944.

Remarks in the Index Card of the Prison Rheinbach: "Vollstreckungsbehörde oder sonstige um Aufnahme ersuchende Behörde, Geschäftszeichen: G.FK.515 St.L.69/44 FP 200 960, Strafbentscheidung: 17.3.44 Straftat: Einbruchdiebstahl, Art und soweit möglich Dauer bzw. Höchstdauer der zu vollstreckenden Strafe: 3 Jahre 6 Mon. Z. (Zuchthaus), Beginn Tag: 17.3.44 Ende Tag: 16.9.47" - Court decision: 17.3.44, Offense: burglary, Sentenced to 3 years and 6 months imprisonment (Zuchthaus), Term of confinement: 17.3.44 to 16.9.47.
