

I was impresented at Maison Darret lan. bafvados France, before that I was held at the St Kelier Prison fersey & I. In the prison at baen France, I suffered from starvation I was confined with a number of other prisoners, I had to sleepfully clothed owing to the sold. I was held in the Jersey prison from the middle of December 1941, to the end of December 1941, and held in the prison of baen France, from the end of December 1941 lo the end of Merch 1942, the time held in France being 3 months

The reason I was imprisoned was
that I was charged with obtaining
German cigarettes after the Germans
had taken a simple statement from
me, I was impresoned without trial,
and held as a hostage during the
time I was imprisoned, I have no
prison number and have no
recollection of ever being issued with
one, the only document I had was
one given to me telling me of my
imprisonment in France, this document
was in my possession some six
months later when I was deported
to Germany, I burnt it when told
I had to be searched, as I feared

or there it could well have ment further trouble for me, I am suffering a permanent dissability as a result of my imprisonment I have not been able to work for many years, and I have been told by doctors that I will never work again. The nature of my disability is Spoudylitis and ylopocitica, which I believe was coursed by the conditions under which I lived in prison, I had very little food and suffered from the cold to the extent that I had to sleep fully clothed including my overcoal during the whole of the time I was imprisoned in trance.
