
Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

ich bin Historiker an der Universität Cambridge und bin mit der Leitung eines Projekt des Staatlichen Museums in Jersey (britische Kanalinseln) beauftragt, das mit der Besatzungszeit von 1940 bis 1945 in Zusammenhang steht. Unser Projekt soll das Schicksal von 88 Deportierten zu dokumentieren, die aus Jersey stammten und über deren Leidensweg sehr wenig bekannt ist. Diese Personen wurden aufgrund verschiedenster politischer Delikte in Gefängnisse und Konzentrationslager auf dem europäischen Festland verbracht, wovon 20 nicht mehr zurückgekehrt sind. Zum fünfzigsten Jahrestag der Befreiung wurden diese 20 Personen durch die Enthüllung einer Gedenktafel in Jersey posthum geehrt.

Dear Mr Dear,

Enclosed please find an inquiry of the historian Paul Sanders concerning 20 persons originating from the British Channel Islands, who did not survive the deportation and the ensuing incarceration during World War II.

As can be seen from the letter, Mr Sanders wants to draw up a documentation about these persons and is therefore interested in knowing their fate.

After checking the documentary material at our disposal, we have been able to ascertain files of previous years for 15 persons.

However, for reasons of data protection, we can only give information about persons registered here to their direct relatives, respectively with their authorization, to third parties. Therefore we are not entitled to provide Mr Sanders, who has repeatedly inquired about the stage of our investigations by phone, with any information about these persons.

Thank you for your letter of September 21st, 1964, reference HC 11811/30 referring to the claims under the Anglo-German Agreement to compensate British victims of Nazi persecution.

I fully understand your intention to trouble the applicants as little as possible by additional questions.

The information given in the two specimen cases mentioned in your letter were entirely sufficient to check our records. Any further enquiries in this form will be agreeable to us.

If, exceptionally, additional information would be necessary for us you would certainly allow us to ask for it. However, if all other cases are as exact and complete as the two specimens I doubt whether this would be necessary.

We send you enclosed excerpts of documents for the two specimen cases. I would like you to tell us quite frankly if you find therein all information you need.

In the case of Peter Edward PAINTER (Specimen Case 1) we found out that we also possess information on his father's detention. We have therefore attached an excerpt for the father as well.

I see from your letter that you will accept as proof of persecution evidence furnished by the applicants. If we can help you by general information on the concentration camps and other Nazi persecution, we shall gladly do so, such as: in which camp and during which period prisoners numbers were tattooed on the forearms of the detainees etcetera.

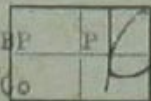
