
Sehr geehrte Damen und Herren,

ich bin Historiker an der Universität Cambridge und bin mit der Leitung eines Projekt des Staatlichen Museums in Jersey (britische Kanalinseln) beauftragt, das mit der Besatzungszeit von 1940 bis 1945 in Zusammenhang steht. Unser Projekt soll das Schicksal von 88 Deportierten zu dokumentieren, die aus Jersey stammten und über deren Leidensweg sehr wenig bekannt ist. Diese Personen wurden aufgrund verschiedenster politischer Delikte in Gefängnisse und Konzentrationslager auf dem europäischen Festland verbracht, wovon 20 nicht mehr zurückgekehrt sind. Zum fünfzigsten Jahrestag der Befreiung wurden diese 20 Personen durch die Enthüllung einer Gedenktafel in Jersey posthum geehrt.

Ich würde gerne in Erfahrung bringen, ob das ITS uns bei unserer Suche unterstützen könnte. Die Namen dieser 20 Personen an denen unser Interesse zunächst am grössten ist liegen anbei zur Kenntnisnahme. Die Namen der übrigen 68 politischen Gefangenen werde ich bei Gelegenheit übersenden. SUBJECT : Identification of casualties who died whilst prisoners of war in Germany.

Sir,

The following has been ascertained in connection with the four casualties in Naumburg/Saale, as referred to by you.

- (1) Fredric PAGE: According to a letter dated 5 January, 1945 from the "Strafgefaengnis und Untersuchungshaftanstalt" in Naumburg/Saale, of which a copy is attached, Frederick Page was imprisoned as a convict in said prison from 3 July, 1944 until his death on 5 January, 1945. No indication is made to the effect that Page was a prisoner of war. We are also attaching copy of a death certificate concerning Frederick William Page, issued by the "Standesamt" in Naumburg/Saale.
- (11) Daile PAISNEL-BOND or Daile PAISNEL: For this individual we hold neither documentation from Naumburg/Saale, nor registration of death.
- (111) CLIFFORD QUEREZ or CLIFFORD BOND QUEREZ: For this case also we have no indications, or documentation from Naumburg/Saale.
- (IV) GEORGES FOX: For Fox Georges, aged 50, born in New Jersey, Locksmith, information is available from the "Ev. Pfarramt, St. Mensel" in Naumburg/Saale, stating that Fox died in Naumburg on 11 March, 1945 and was buried in the cemetery of the St. Mensel Parish, Naumburg.

Owing to the fact that former tracing enquiries for the persons referred to in (1) (11) and (IV) give as last address: Frankfurt/Main, 112 Hamburgerstrasse, which is the address of a prison, it is possible that these individuals, as was the case with Page, were transferred from Frankfurt/Main to the Naumburg prison and died there. We believe that these casualties are also registered in Naumburg/Saale (Russian Zone of Germany) and would suggest your making application there.

It may interest you that we hold old tracing requests for Fox, made by his brother, Mr. S.E. Fox o/o Red Cross, Message Bureau, 201 Clarence House, St. James's, London S.W.1, dated 7 November, 1945, and for Paisnel-Bond, made by his son Mr. E.J. Paisnel-Bond, o/o Red Cross Message Bureau, as above.

We trust to have been of some service to you.

Dear Mr Dear,

Enclosed please find an inquiry of the historian Paul Sanders concerning 20 persons originating from the British Channel Islands, who did not survive the deportation and the ensuing incarceration during World War II.

As can be seen from the letter, Mr Sanders wants to draw up a documentation about these persons and is therefore interested in knowing their fate.

After checking the documentary material at our disposal, we have been able to ascertain files of previous years for 15 persons.

However, for reasons of data protection, we can only give information about persons registered here to their direct relatives, respectively with their authorization, to third parties. Therefore we are not entitled to provide Mr Sanders, who has repeatedly inquired about the stage of our investigations by phone, with any information about these persons.
