Ex-Police Sergeant PERCY WILLIAM MILLER, protestant,
resident at La Turquie, Vale, Guernsey, died on the 16th
July 1944 at 112 Homburger Landstrasse, Frankfort on Main,
at 6 hours 30 minutes.

The deceased was born on the 1st March 1883 in Guernsey,
(registry ----- No. -----).

Father: Unknown. Mother: Unknown.

The deceased was married to Maud Eveline, nee HARRIS.

The death was registered as the result of a report from the
competent registrar's official.

There is no equivalent in English of "Kriminal-Wachtmeister", and I
assume that Sergeant is meant. I have not translated the printed words
