The Commission are endeavouring to identify a number of casualties who died whilst prisoners of war in German hands and they would be most grateful for your assistance in this matter.

I should explain that there are, in particular, four graves in Berlin 1939/45 War Cemetery bearing fairly comprehensive details of the occupents, and as it has not been possible to associate their particulars with any known British casualty it is believed that you may have record of such missing persons on your files for different missing Nationals.

Before concentration to Berlin 1939/45 War Cemetery in January 1949 these four casualties were buried in NAUMBERG Cemetery and from the limited evidence available it would seem that they died in the local civilian or military hospital.

The particulars of these four casualties were recorded by the Germans as follows:-

The following has been ascertained in connection with the four casualties in Naumburg/Saale, as referred to by you.

- (1) <u>Predris PAGE:</u> According to a letter dated 5 January, 1945 from the "Strafgefäengnis uni Untersuchungshaftanstalt" in Naumburg/Saale, of which a copy is attached. Prederick Page was imprisoned as a convict in said prison from 5 July, 1944 until his death on 5 January, 1945. No indication is made to the affect that Page was a prisoner of war. We are also attaching copy of a death certificate concerning Prederick William Page, issued by the "Standesast" in Naumburg/Saale.
- (ii) <u>Mmile PAISML-ROND or Emile PAISMEL</u>: For this individual we hold neither documentation from Naumburg/Saale, nor registration of death.
- (iii)CLIFFORD QUEREE or CLIFFORD BOND QUEREE: For this case also we have no indications, or documentation from Haumburg/Saale.
- (39) <u>GEORGES FOX:</u> For Fox Georges, aged 50, bern in New Jersey, lockamith, information is available from the "Ev. Pfarrant, St.Mensel" in Naumburg/Saale, stating that Fox died in Naumburg on 11 March, 1945 and was buried in the cometery of the St. Mensel Parish, Haumburg.

Owing to the fast that former tracing enquiries for the persons referred to in (i) (ii) and (IV) give as last address: Frankfurt/Main, 112 Hamburgerstrasse, which is the address of a prison, it is possible that these individuals, as was the case with Page, were transferred from Frankfurt/Main to the Mausburg prison and died there. We believe that these casualties are also registered in Mausburg/Saale (Russian Zone of Germany) and would suggest your making application there.

It may interest you that we hold old tracing requests for Fox, made by his brather, Mr. S.E. Fox c/o Red Cress, Message Bursau, 201 Clarence House, St. James's, London S.W.1, dated 7 Hovember, 1945, and for Paisnel-Bond, made by his son Mr. E.J. Paisnel-Bond, c/o Red Cross Message Bursau, as above.

With reference to your letter dated 4th November 1964, please be advised that the following information is contained in our records:

PAGE, Frederik, William, born 20 November 1900 in Portsmouth, England, Nationality: British, - was in the "Strafanstalt Frankfurt/Main-Preungesheim"in the year 1943 (exact date unknown). Document 1367/43 issued by the "Strafanstalt Frankfurt/ Main-Freungesheim" and Document 2 VLs 170/44 issued by the "Oberstaatsanwalt Frankfurt/Main". He died on 5 January 1945 and was buried in Naumburg/ Saale.

Documents consulted: Nominal lists established by the "Oberstaatsanwalt Frankfurt/Main"; Nominal Roll of deceased PW's or DP's.

As can be seen from the letter, Mr Sanders wants to draw up a documentation about these persons and is therefore interested in knowing their fate.


After checking the documentary material at our disposal, we have been able to ascertain files of previous years for 15 persons.



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
