ANNEX "A"

20 August, 1945.

Instructions for Operating Plan to Trace Relatives of Displaced Persons in Assembly
Centres in Germany

1. Lists (Annex "C") should be carefully completed in accordance with Instructions (Annex "B") and forwarded at once to CDPX, through channels.
2. The lists will be reproduced and a copy of all lists will be distributed to all Assembly Centres. These lists should then be posted (with appropriate translations of headings) in places accessible to all displaced persons in the Centre or otherwise made available to them so that they may search them.
3. The names of all persons discovered through this plan should be reported immediately to CDPX, giving surname, Christian names, nationality, list number and serial number. Those not so discovered will be indexed by the Central Tracing Bureau and checked against information constantly being received.
4. Persons who discover location of relatives through this plan should be instructed to inform the Assembly Centre Director or appropriate staff official at once. The latter should arrange for the relative concerned to be informed (where necessary through Mil. Gov. channels at the appropriate level) and for arrangements to be made with Mil. Gov. for one to join the other where possible. It is important that both parties understand which is to move, so as to avoid duplication of movement. If no other means are available these messages may be passed through the Central Tracing Bureau.
5. The fullest publicity among displaced persons should be given to this plan and to the lists when circulated.
6. The instructions contained in Annex "B" must be explicitly carried out in order to expedite the efficient execution of the plan.
7. Comments and information on the working of the plan will be appreciated by the Central Tracing Bureau of CDPX.
8. Forms will be made available later in which individual requests may be submitted to the Central Tracing Bureau for tracing persons in Germany who are not in Assembly Centres
